Narre Warren Police Station

arete Australia has commenced works on the upgrade and refurbishment of the Narre Warren Police Station, delivering a contemporary and community-focused facility that enhances service delivery for both Victoria Police and the wider public.

The project is being delivered in two key stages, carefully planned to ensure continuous police operations throughout construction. Stage one involves the setup of a temporary facility to accommodate staff, allowing police to remain fully operational during the refurbishment works.
